Toronto based SideFX is a world leader in the development of visual effects and 3D animation, whose software has proven to be a game changer for screen based industries. Its procedural node technology called Houdini provides simulation tools to VFX artists, allowing them to create highly realistic visual effects, which has added a whole new dimension to modern filmmaking and transformed an industry. By making the impossible shot possible, Houdini has become an industry standard, with its applications evident in many of today's television shows such as the Emmy winning "Vikings" and blockbuster films like the Oscar winning "The Shape of Water".




