### CSC's Field of Vision Mentorship Program helps break down barriers ...

- Full CSC Members and Associate Members with 10 years or more experience will mentor Associate, Affiliate and Companion Level Members with less than 10 years' experience.
- The CSC Mentorship Team will pair mentees with a CSC Mentor.
- Mentors and Mentees will meet, for 10 sessions of at least one hour each over the course of a year.
- Involvement can include in-person or online meetings, set visits, feedback on the mentee's work, discussion of techniques, career advice—any number of other opportunities that the mentors may be able to offer.

Your contribution of \$1,398 for a mentorship sponsor will help camera arts professionals from underrepresented groups overcome obstacles and advance their careers.

... wanting to join a network of people they can learn from, and have an opportunity to better understand the industry they hope to work in.


Many of the best DPs working today have started out this way.




