The past few years have been a period of transformation for the CSC. With a 55% increase in membership, we are reaching more cinematographers every day.

CSC is no longer a Toronto-only based organization. We have CSC Vancouver housed at Keslow Camera; CSC Montreal housed at CineGround, in addition to CSC Toronto housed at Sunbelt Rentals Film & TV/William F. White Int'l. Inc. All three locations offer product demos, meetings, educational activities and screenings.

We have also organized several successful workshops; two virtual production masterclasses have been developed and delivered, setting the bar for virtual production training in North America; and specialist training workshops, such as exterior night lighting, was introduced in Toronto in 2023 and is planned for Vancouver in 2024.

The on-going Field of View Mentorship Program continues to attract emerging cinematographers. Sixty members are currently being mentored by full

CSC members. Our on-line content has grown to encompass hundreds of thousands of viewers.

The organization's determination and commitment have allowed us to weather both the covid pandemic and two industry strikes.
